months 1-3



WELCOME TO THE WORLD, KITTEN!

Most kittens are still with their mum at this stage. They will start to be weaned onto kitten food, and be taken for their first vet check-up.



GETTING TO KNOW YOU

Your kitten will get their first vaccination, and also start socialising. Some pet parents may bring their kitten home at the end of this month.



LET'S GET PHYSICAL

Your kitty will need more vaccinations. It's also time to get them used to grooming, handling, and wearing a collar.

months 4-6



BUILDING GOOD HABITS

Continue to socialise your kitten, and ask your vet about flea control products.



TIME TO HAVE "THE TALK"

Talk to your vet about the pros and cons, and timing, of spaying or neutering your kitten.



SMILE!

Your kitten may have lost all baby teeth by now, and have a full set of adult teeth. They are approaching their teenage years - be sure to provide plenty of exercise and mental stimulation.

months 9-15



THEY GROW UP SO FAST

Kittens will appear fully grown, but they still need to be fed a special kitten food.



HAPPY FIRST BIRTHDAY, KITTEN!

Your kitten is now considered an adult cat. Their dietary needs may vary, so ask your vet about transitioning to adult cat food.



FOLLOWING UP

Visit your vet for your first annual adult cat check-up and vaccinations.
